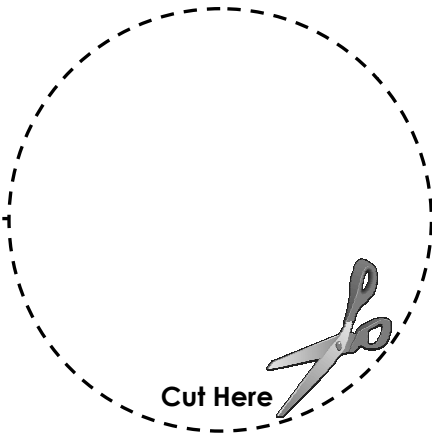


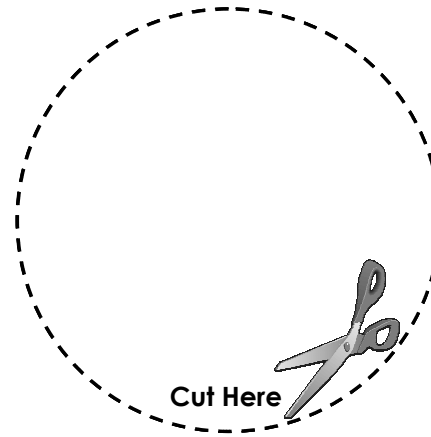

What You Can Do

1. Ask About Housing

Ask questions (listed on other side) when a candidate knocks on your door, at forums or during other times (listed below)

2. Know Your Candidates

Find out their position on housing by asking questions and researching votes, policy positions, news, etc.

3. Connect with Your Candidates

Place a call or write a letter/email in support of housing

4. Meet Your Candidates

Attend a candidate forum, town-hall meeting, debate, etc. to get to know them and ask them questions

5. Tell Your Friends

Print this off and pass it around to get the word out to friends who care about housing

6. VOTE!

Questions to Ask Door-Knocking Candidates

Nearly all counties statewide have seen significant increases in foreclosures in the last year. **What is your plan to address the growing foreclosure crisis and how do you plan to provide those who are facing foreclosure with options?**

Many people who work cannot afford housing despite having a source of income. Since their jobs do not pay enough to afford housing, **how do you plan to ensure that employed people can afford safe, stable housing?**

Often, the only affordable housing is several miles away from a person's workplace. **What is the state's role in making sure that affordable, low-income housing exists near places of employment?**

When road projects eliminate manufactured (mobile) home communities, the residents usually cannot find comparable replacement housing in the same city. **Do you support a one-for-one replacement requirement of affordable home ownership opportunities for displaced manufactured housing residents?**

If elected, **would you join or participate in the housing caucus being established at the Minnesota State Legislature?**
